REGISTRATION- What do I get? Your registration fee covers a number of things, payment to soccer NSW, player insurance, MDSFA administration costs and club administration costs. As part of season 2010 each player, coach and manager will be provided with a club training shirt. It is expected that all players wear these shirts to training so as to show our sponsors our full support

UNIFORMS- socks and shorts sets are available for purchase. Additionally we have a number of different apparel items that can be ordered

REGISTRATION FEES- Payment of registration fees is required to be finalised by 8 May 2010. In the event registration fees are outstanding at this time you or your child will not be permitted to take the field until the matter is resolved. If you are having difficulty in meeting your obligations then please speak to me well before this date.

MATCH FEES- Why do I have to pay them? Match fees are charged to cover a game fee which is charged by the association, it also covers referees and linesman. Match fees are due and payable each week. In the event a player falls more than 3 weeks behind in these payments, the player will not be permitted to take the field until the matter is resolved.

CHOCOLATE FUNDRAISER- Throughout the year we will allocate each player a box of chocolates to sell. It is expected that each player return the proceeds of the sale of these within 3 weeks. The profit generated from these is applied directly to our trophies for presentation day

WET WEATHER-In the event of wet weather the club has a mobile number which has a recorded message regarding ground closures. The number is 0406 146 722

TRAINING-Training will commence in late February/early March dependant on council and the usage of Hurley Park. Your training night will be determined by your coach in general consultation with your team.
